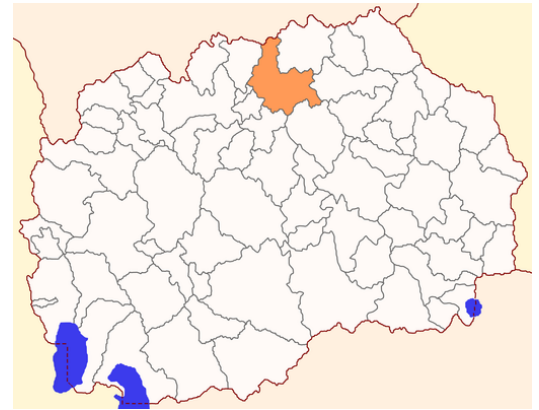




MUNICIPALITY OF KUMANOVO

Ethnic structure: 55.80% Macedonians; 25.99% Albanians; 0.15% Turks; 2.85% Roma; 0.12% Vlachs; 6.52% Serbs; 0.04% Bosniaks; 0.71% Others

ECONOMY AND BUSINESS

Enterprise structure: The largest number of enterprises are micro and small, and middle-sized and large ones are fewer.
Sectors: wholesale and retail trade, processing industry, transport and storage, accommodation facilities and food service activities, etc.

Production: The most widespread are grains, garden crops, vines and wine production, orchards, etc.
