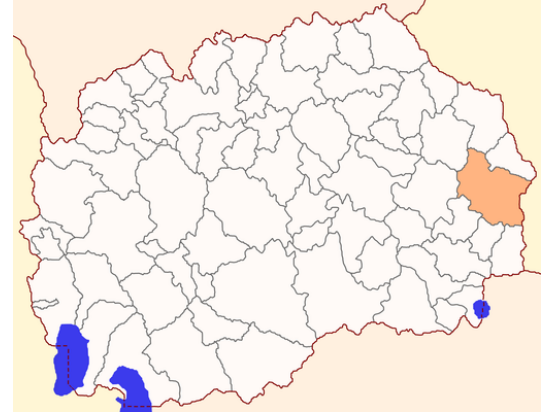




MUNICIPALITY OF BEROVO

LAG Malesh-Pijanec

The Berovo valley covers the easternmost part of the country. The municipality of Berovo borders the municipalities of Novo Selo, Bosilovo, Vasilevo, Radovich, Vinica, Delchevo and Pehchevo and the state border of the Republic of Bulgaria. The relief is mostly hilly and mountainous with flat terrains only around the riverbed of Bregalnica River.

Enterprise structure: The largest number of enterprises are micro and small.
Sectors: wholesale and retail trade, processing industry, transport and storage, agriculture, forestry, hunting and fishing, etc.

Production: The most widespread are fruits (plums, apples, cherries), grains (wheat and corn), etc.
