


MUNICIPALITY OF DELCHEVO

LAG Malesh-Pijanec

The municipality of Delchevo is located in the northeastern part of the country, at the foot of Golak Mountain. Vlaina Mountain, Osogovo, and Maleshevo Mountains surround it. It is located in the Pijanec valley and spreads along the upper reaches of the Bregalnica River. It borders the municipalities of Pehchevo, Berovo, Vinica, Makedonska Kamenica, and the Republic of Bulgaria.

Eastern-European with a modified pluviometer regime. The average annual temperature is 10.7 °C.
