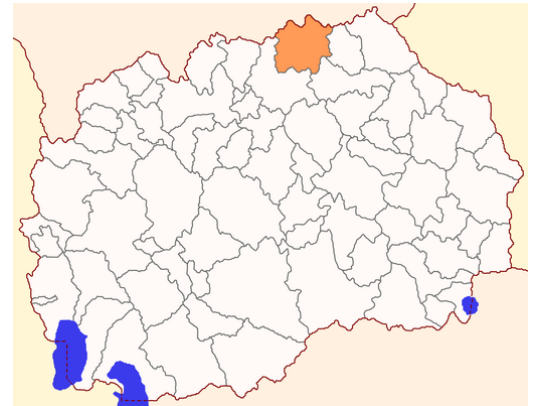




# MUNICIPALITY OF STARO NAGORICHANE

Staro Nagorichane is a municipality in the northern part of the country. The largest part of the municipality is located on Kozjak Mountain and its southern slopes, on the eastern slopes of Mount Ruen, and through the valley of the Pchinja River. It borders the municipalities of Kratovo, Rankovce, Kumanovo, and the Republic of Serbia.

Moderate with modified Mediterranean influences in the pluviometric regime. The average annual temperature is 11 °C.

Total population: 3,501  
Ethnic structure: 71.78% Macedonians; 0.37% Albanians; 0.09% Roma; 16.71% Serbs; 0.26% Others



## ECONOMY AND BUSINESS

Enterprise structure: The largest number of enterprises are micro and small.  
Sectors: agriculture, forestry, hunting and fishing, wholesale and retail trade, etc.



## AGRICULTURE

Cultivable area: 13,785 ha  
Agricultural area: 21,500 ha  
Production: The most widespread are grains, vines and production of grapes and wine, vegetables, fruits, etc.
