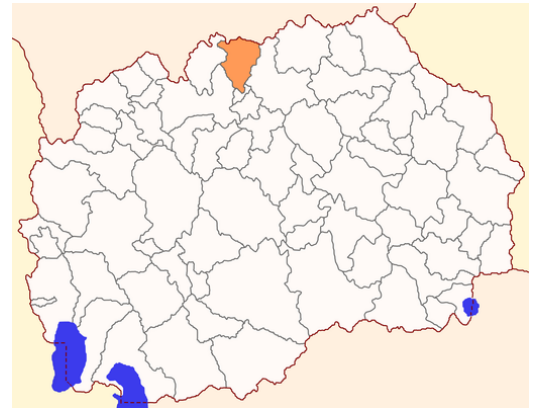




MUNICIPALITY OF LIPKOVO

The municipality of Lipkovo is a municipality in the northern part of the country. It stretches on the slopes of Skopska Crna Gora and the Macedonian part of the Zegligovo Valley, along the course of the Lipkovo River. The municipality borders the city of Skopje, the municipalities of Chucher Sandevo, Arachinovo, and Kumanovo, and the Republic of Kosovo and the Republic of Serbia.

NATURAL RESOURCES

Forests: 9,968 ha

Pastures: 544 ha

Water resources: rivers Lipkovska, Lojanska, Vaksinska, Otljanska, Matejchka and Slupchanska; water accumulations Lipkovo Lake and Glaznja; spring of mineral and thermal water in the Karadac region



CLIMATE

Characteristic significant decrease in air temperature and amounts of snow mass. The bed of the Vardar River to the north carries Mediterranean air currents.

Total population: 22,308

Ethnic structure: 0.15% Macedonians; 96.65% Albanians; 0.02% Serbs; 0.02% Bosniaks; 0.02% Others



ECONOMY AND BUSINESS

Enterprise structure: The largest number of enterprises are micro and small.

Sectors: wholesale and retail trade, processing industry, transport and storage, construction, etc.

Cultivable area: 6,912 ha

Agricultural area: 7,456 ha

Production: The most widespread are grains, vegetables, fodder crops, etc.
