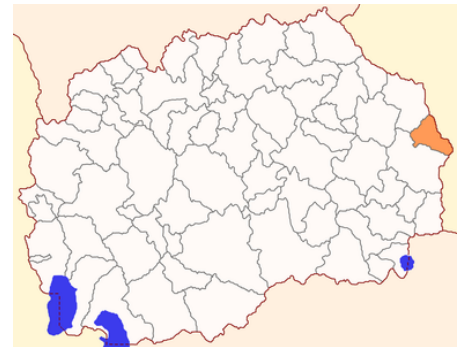




MUNICIPALITY OF PEHCHEVO

LAG Malesh-Pijanec

The municipality of Pehchevo is located in the eastern part of the country, in the north-eastern part of the Maleshevo Valley, next to the border with the Republic of Bulgaria. It borders the municipalities of Berovo, Delchevo, and Simitli in Bulgaria.

Influence of a continental climate with moderately hot summers and cold winters. The average annual temperature is 8.9 °C.



POPULATION

Total population: 3,983

Ethnic structure: 81.17% Macedonians; 0.03% Albanians; 7.03% Turks; 6.43% Roma; 0.03% Vlachs; 0.25% Serbs; 0.03% Bosniaks; 0.80% Others



ECONOMY AND BUSINESS

Enterprise structure: The largest number of enterprises are micro and small, and middle-sized are rarer.

Sectors: wholesale and retail trade, agriculture, forestry, hunting and fishing, processing industry, etc.



AGRICULTURE

Cultivable area: 5,113 ha

Agricultural area: 11,570 ha

Production: The most widespread are fruits (plum, cherry), grains (wheat, corn), etc.



EDUCATION

Literate: 3,369 (51.14% male, 48.86% female)

Illiterate: 66 (28.79% male, 71.21% female)
