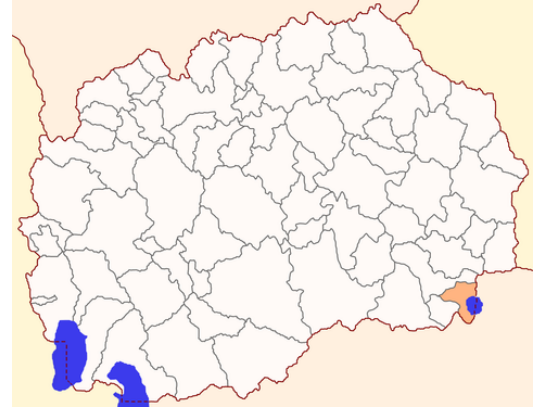




MUNICIPALITY OF DOJRAN

The municipality is located on the shores of the Dojran Lake, between the Belasica, Krusha, and Karabalia mountains. It borders the municipalities of Bogdanci and Valandovo.
