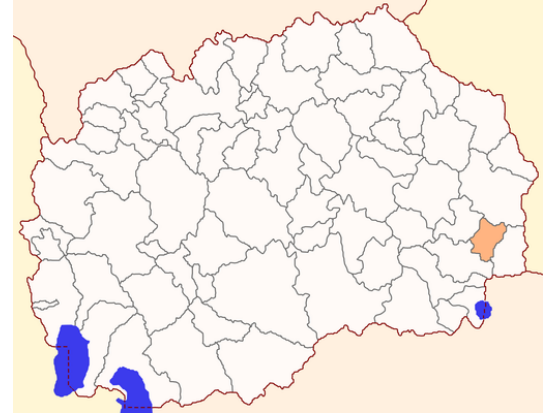




# MUNICIPALITY OF BOSILOVO

LAG Belasica-Ograzden

The territory of the municipality of Bosilovo extends to the far southeast of the country and one part occupies the central part of Strumica Valley, while the other part rises to the crest of Mount Ograzden. It borders the neighboring municipalities: Berovo, Strumica, Vasilevo, and Novo Selo.

Influence of sub-Mediterranean and continental climate. A reduced amount of precipitation and a reduced winter temperature are characteristic.

Total population: 11,508

Ethnic structure: 84.83% Macedonians; 0.06% Albanians; 5.88% Turks; 0.14% Roma; 0.05% Serbs; 0.13% Others

Enterprise structure: The largest number of enterprises are micro and small.

Sectors: wholesale and retail trade, processing industry, agriculture, forestry, hunting and fishing, transport and storage, etc.
