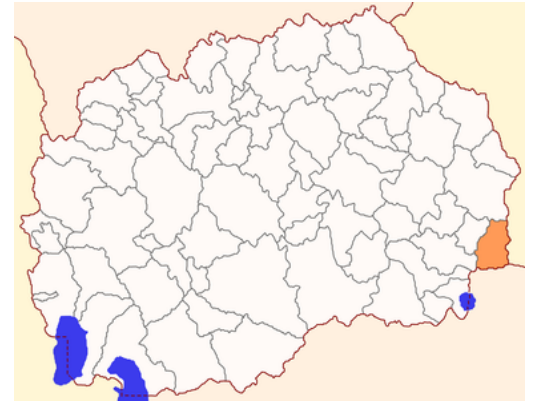




# MUNICIPALITY OF NOVO SELO

LAG Belasica-Ograzden

The municipality of Novo Selo is located in the extreme southeastern part of the country and borders the municipalities of Strumica, Berovo, and Bosilovo on the Macedonian side and the municipalities of Petrich and Muries on the Bulgarian and Greek sides. The highest waterfall in the country is located on its territory (Smolarski waterfalls - 39.5 m).

Modified Mediterranean climate, characterized by long, hot summers and short, snowy winters.

Enterprise structure: The largest number of enterprises are micro and small.
