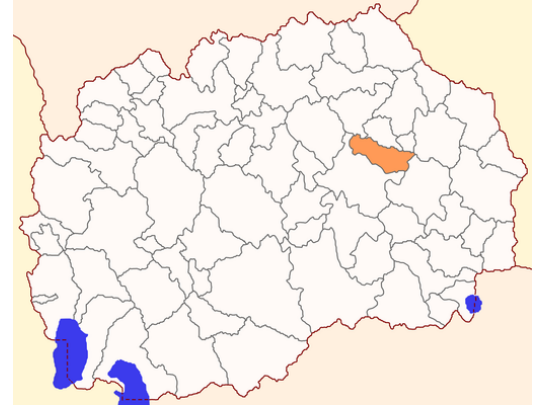




MUNICIPALITY OF KARBINCI
